

Data Privacy Information

1. General

WILHELM BAHMÜLLER GmbH, hereinafter referred to as BAHMÜLLER, respects the privacy of each person who visits our Internet presence. We would like to inform you of what data we collect and how we use it. You will also learn how you can verify the accuracy of this information and arrange for the deletion of this data from BAHMÜLLER. Data is collected, processed and used in compliance with statutory data privacy regulations. This Data Privacy Information does not apply for websites on the Internet where you can visit BAHMÜLLER via hyperlinks on said websites.

2. Collection, use and processing of personal information

We collect data relating to a specific person for processing and use only when you voluntarily decide to input the data or explicitly declare your consent. In such cases, you thereby accept the following terms of use.

By visiting our website, certain information is automatically saved on our servers for purposes of system administration, statistics or security. This includes the name of your Internet service provider, under certain circumstances your IP address, the version of your browser software, the operating system of the accessing computer, the website from which you visited us, the pages you visit with us and keywords you may have used in order to find our website. Under certain circumstances, this information can allow conclusions to be drawn about certain visitors to the website. However, personal information is not used in this context. The use of such information is strictly anonymous. If **BAHMÜLLER** forwards data to external service providers, technical and organizational measures are undertaken to ensure that said forwarding occurs in compliance with the legal provisions for data privacy.

If you yourself provide us with personal information, we will not use, process or forward this data beyond that which is legally permissible or that which you specify by your declaration of consent. Furthermore, we will only forward your information if we are legally obligated to do so by official or judicial order.

Changes to our "Data Privacy Information" are published on this page. You can thereby always be informed of what information we save and how we collect and use it.

Of course, you are also entitled to revoke your declared consent for the use and processing of personal information at any time, with effect for the future. 3. Security

BAHMÜLLER will store your information securely, and therefore undertake all precautionary measures to protect your information from loss, misuse or modification. Contractual partners of **BAHMÜLLER**, who have access to your information in order to provide you with services on behalf of **BAHMÜLLER** are contractually obligated to keep said information secret and may not use it for other purposes.

4. Personal information about children

BAHMÜLLER does not intend to collect personal information about people under 14 years of age. **BAHMÜLLER** will - when necessary - explicitly notify children at the most appropriate location that they should not transmit personal information to **BAHMÜLLER**.

5. Cookies

We use so-called cookies to facilitate the use of our website. "Cookies" are small pieces of information that are temporarily saved on your computer's hard disk by your browser and are required for use of our website. The information contained in the cookies is used for session control, particularly for improving navigation, and enables a website to be highly user-friendly. The cookies we use do not save any person-specific information. Cookies are automatically accepted by most web browsers. You can prevent this by changing your browser's settings. You



can remove cookies saved on your PC at any time by deleting temporary Internet files (browser menu Settings - Internet Options).

6. Your requests and questions | Data privacy officer

Saved information is deleted by **BAHMÜLLER** when the statutory or contractual retention period has elapsed or insofar as **BAHMÜLLER** no longer requires the information. Of course, you have the option of requesting the deletion of your information at any time.

You are naturally also entitled to revoke your declared consent for the use or processing of personal information at any time, with effect for the future. 7. Public register of proceedings

The German Federal Data Privacy Act (BDSG) stipulates in § 4g that the data privacy officer must make the following information available in accordance with § 4e to all interested parties:

- (4) Purpose of data collection, processing or use:

The purpose of the business is the production, sales and assembly of mechanical engineering and the production of precision tools

The corporation may acquire domestic and foreign companies of all kinds or participate in them and do any business and action which is conducive to the objects of the corporation.

- (5) Description of the groups of people affected and the data or data categories held in this respect:

 Data relating to customers, employees, pensioners, employees of affiliated companies, employees of external companies (subcontractors), leasing personnel, job applicants, external inventors or heirs, respectively, suppliers and service-providers, external customers, consumers, volunteers in consumer tests, visitors to the corporations site, investors as well as financial analysts and shareholders insofar as necessary for fulfilling the purposes specified under paragraph 7 (4).
- (6) Recipients or categories of recipient to whom the data might be disclosed:
 Public authorities, health insurance funds and employers' liability association in the event of the presence of the relevant legal regulations, external contractors in accordance with §11 BDSG, external service-providers, affiliated companies.
- (7) Standard periods for the deletion of data:

The legislature prescribes a variety of obligations and periods concerning retaining and deleting data. After expiration of these periods, the corresponding data is routinely deleted. Any data not covered by these regulations is deleted when the purposes stipulated no longer apply.

(8) Planned transmission of data to other countries:

As part of a global information system, the personal information is made available to selected management executives in other countries. Corresponding data privacy agreements in accordance with EU standard are contractually agreed upon with the respective companies.



8. Use of Facebook social plugins

Under certain circumstances, social plugins ("plugins") of the social network facebook.com, which are operated by Facebook Inc., 1601 S. California Ave, Palo Alto, CA 94304, USA ("Facebook"), can be used on our website. These particularly include Facebook's "Like" button.

When you visit a webpage from our Internet presence which contains such a plugin, your Internet browser establishes a direct connection to Facebook's servers. The content of the plugin is transmitted from Facebook directly to your browser, which integrates it into the webpage.

By means of said integration, Facebook receives the information that you have visited the corresponding page of our Internet presence. If you are logged into Facebook via your user account while visiting our webpage, Facebook can allocate the visit to your Facebook account. When you interact with the plugins, such as by clicking the "Like" button or submitting a comment, the corresponding information is transmitted from your browser directly to Facebook and stored there.
